Sydney Harbour Tunnel - change to radio communications system

Issue

The radio communications system fitted within the Sydney Harbour Tunnel has been upgraded.

A Government Radio Network (GRN) base station has been installed, meaning that normal GRN communications talkgroups can now be used in both the Northbound and Southbound carriageways.

The procedure for the use of GRN-enabled radio transceivers in the tunnel has therefore changed.

New procedure

Crews attending incidents in the Sydney Harbour Tunnel should communicate with Sydney Communication Centre on radio talkgroup 101 Sydney 01.

All other GRN radio talkgroups are also available for use if required throughout the tunnel.

This change brings the Sydney Harbour Tunnel into line with other major Sydney road tunnels which all have GRN communications systems fitted.

The old radio rebroadcast system on talkgroups 105 and 106 has been decommissioned, and can no longer be used.
