## Roof ladder

All roof ladders that are part of the appliance inventory or stored on station premises are to be returned immediately to the following address.

A roof ladder is distinguished by a hooked end and can be either fibreglass or wood. Station Commanders should ensure that roof ladders are tagged with station name, number and appliance registration number and an entry made in the occurrence book stating the same.

Roof ladders can be delivered via courier or stations in the GSA can deliver them to Greenacre themselves.
